Regulations of the Nice To Fit You Mini Marathon

I. The Organizer

- The Organizer of Nice To Fit You Mini Marathon is Warsaw Marathon Foundation. 15
 Brylantowa str., 05-077 Warsaw, registered under Taxpayer Identification Number (NIP)
 9521913280 and Business Identification Number (REGON) 015438288.

II. Date and location

- 1. The race will take place on September 27, 2025, in Warsaw, near the Palace of Culture and Science. The organizer reserves the right to change the race location and will inform participants by posting the new route on the website nnmaratonwarszawski.com. Such a change will not give rise to any additional claims or liabilities.
- 2. The category, distance, and start time depend on the child's age:
 - i. Bąbel Run up to 3 years old (2022-2025) approx. 50 meters start at approximately 11:00 AM
 - ii. Kransnal Run 4-5 years old (2020-2021) approx. 100 meters start at approximately 12:00 PM
 - iii. Smyk Run 6-7 years old (2018-2019) approx. 150 meters start at approximately 1:00 PM
 - iv. Urwis Run 8-9 years old (2016-2017) approx. 200 meters start at approximately 1:50 PM
 - v. Zuch Run 10-11 years old (2014-2015) approx. 400 meters start at approximately 2:30 PM
 - vi. Junior Run 12-13 (2012-2013) approx. 600 meters start at approximately 3:00 PM
 - vii. Teen Run 14-16 years (2009-2011) approx. 1,200 meters start at approximately 3:20 PM
- 3. The times provided are approximate. Exact start times will be announced on https://nnmaratonwarszawski.com/ approximately one week before the race.

III. Participation

- 1. Children up to 16 years of age (born in 2009 or later) are eligible to participate in the Nice To Fit You Mini Marathon.
- 2. Around 80 children can participate in each round (40 children in the Babel Run and Krasnal Run). The Organizer plans to organize one or more rounds in each age category. The Organizer plans to conduct rounds at 5, 10, or 15-minute intervals (depending on the distance). The number of rounds in each category is determined by the Organizer. Participants are automatically assigned to a round upon payment of the entry fee. It is not possible to select or change rounds. The Organizer will notify participants on the event website when the limit for a given age category has been reached.
- 3. Participants will start the races independently (without a parent/guardian). The exceptions are the two youngest age categories (up to 3 years and 4-5 years), where a child may participate with one parent/guardian. Older children with special needs may participate with one parent/guardian after notifying the Organizer upon collecting their race package at the Race Office
- 4. All participants must be verified at the Race Office. Verification can be performed by the person registering the child or a person designated by them. This will be done using the QR code the person who registered the participant will receive on the day the Race Office is opened. Alongside the QR code, the following are also required: the child's ID document confirming age (a photocopy or photograph of the document) and the parent/legal guardian's consent form (available for download from the website approximately two weeks before the race) with the signature of the child's parent/legal guardian.

- 5. At the Race Office, participants will receive their race packages, which include: a race number, timing chip, and safety pins.
- 6. Race packages not collected at the Run Office will not be shipped or issued at a later date.
- 7. During the race, all participants must wear their race numbers attached horizontally to the front of their shirts (or sweatshirts or jackets). The race number must be visible throughout the race. Covering the race number (in whole or in part, during any part of the race) or modifying it is prohibited under penalty of disqualification.
- 8. The Organizer will provide medical services at the start, course, and finish line during the race.

IV. Registration

- 1. Registrations are accepted via the registration form available on the websites: nnmaratonwarszawski.com and rejestracja.maratonwarszawski.com.
- 2. Registrations are submitted by a parent/guardian using their account on the website indicated in section IV.1.
- 3. An entry is considered complete if the following conditions are met: the entry form is completed and payment of the entry fee is received. Completing the entry form alone does not guarantee a place in the Race.
- 4. Online registration will close on September 26, 2025. Registration for the race will also be possible in person at the Nice To Fit You Mini Marathon Race Office (on September 27, 2025 only).
- 5. The organizer reserves the right to close registration early if the participant limits specified in section III. 2.

V. Fees

- 1. The entry fee for the Run is PLN 39.00 per participant.
- 2. Participants have the option to order an additional service: medal engraving, valued at PLN 25.00.
- 3. The entry fee can be paid online (from the registration profile) via https://www.payu.pl/. PayU S.A., ul. Grunwaldzka 182, 60-166 Poznań, is responsible for the settlement and security of online payments. PayU S.A., located at ul. Grunwaldzka 182, 60-166 Poznań, NIP 7792308495, REGON 300523444, is a national payment institution supervised by the Polish Financial Supervision Authority, entered in the Register of Payment Services under number IP1/2012.
- 4. Proof of payment is the appearance of the starting number next to the participant's name on the start list at nnmaratonwarszawski.com. If the starting number does not appear after 7 days, the participant is required to contact the organizer by phone: (+48) 503-860-516 or by email: info@maratonwarszawski.com.
- 5. The organizer is not responsible for lost registration or transfer if any third party is responsible, eg, bank or post office.
- 6. Once paid, the fee is non-refundable and non-transferable to another person or to another race organized by the "Warsaw Marathon" Foundation.
- 7. Those wishing to receive an invoice for the entry fee should select the appropriate option on the registration form and provide the required information. The invoice will be generated automatically after payment is received and will be available for download from the participant's profile by the 15th day of the month following the month in which payment was made. In accordance with tax regulations, due to payment being made before the service is provided, an advance payment invoice will be issued for the full amount of the fee. Therefore, the advance payment invoice is also the final invoice. By selecting the "Invoice" option, the Participant consents to the sending/sharing of invoices, without the recipient's signature, in electronic form. This consent does not exclude the Organizer's right to issue and send invoices in paper form.
- 8. To receive a pro-forma invoice, please send the following information: invoice details, number of runners, and a list of runners (with entry numbers) to ksiegowosc@maratonwarszawski.com. Pro-forma invoices are issued for the participation of at least two runners (it is not possible to receive a pro-forma invoice for the participation of a single runner).

VI. Deposits

- Participants will be able to deposit their belongings in a designated area. Items can only be retrieved with their race number. If a participant loses their race number, the Organizer is released from responsibility for the items being retrieved by another person. Please note: Valuables and documents are prohibited from being left in the deposit.
- 2. Participants will have access to a changing room before and after the race.

VII. Classification and Results

- 1. The following classifications will be held during the Nice To Fit You Mini Marathon (separately for each age category, each classification is based on the combined results of individual races):
 - i. General Classification
 - ii. General Boys'/Girls' Classification
- 2. The classification is based on electronic timekeeping.
- 3. The general classification is based on official times (gross from the starter's shot).
- 4. Unofficial race results will be posted on nnmaratonwarszawski.com immediately after the race.
- 5. Written challenges regarding the results are accepted until 6:00 PM on September 29, 2025, at info@maratonwarszawski.com. Challenges will be reviewed within 96 hours, and the final and official results will be published no later than October 14, 2025.
- 6. The printable Nice To Fit You Mini Marathon completion certificate will be available for download at marathonwarszawski.com no later than 21 days after the event.
- 7. The organizer reserves the right to introduce additional classifications.

VIII. Prizes

- 1. All participants who complete the Nice To Fit You Mini Marathon will receive commemorative medals at the finish line.
- 2. The 1st-3rd place finishers in the general classifications for both girls and boys will receive commemorative trophies.
- 3. The organizer reserves the right to provide additional prizes in the categories and classifications of their choice.

IX. Personal Data Protection

- Participants' personal data will be processed in accordance with applicable regulations, in particular Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation).
- 2. The data processing referred to in Section XI. 1. also includes the publication of: first name, last name, year of birth, city name, and club name.
- 3. Detailed information regarding the processing of personal data is included in Appendix 1 to these regulations.

X. Final Provisions

- It is prohibited to use bicycles, roller skates, skateboards, other mechanical devices, or strollers
 on the race route without a valid permit issued by the Organizer. Nordic walking poles and
 running with dogs are also prohibited. Only organizer vehicles with a valid pass issued by the
 Organizer are permitted on the route.
- 2. During the race, participants must follow the instructions given by safety personnel, security personnel, and other persons designated by the Organizer.
- 3. The Organizer provides each participant with personal accident insurance for the duration of the race.
- 4. The parent/legal guardian of each participant is required to sign a declaration confirming their knowledge of the regulations. By signing the aforementioned declaration, the parent/legal guardian consents to the provision of first aid, other medical procedures, and transportation of the injured person to a safe place by medical and paramedical personnel acting on behalf of the Organizer.
- 5. The parent/legal guardian declares that the participant is fit to participate in the race, is not aware of any health-related reasons that would exclude them from participating, and is participating at their own risk. They acknowledge that participating in the race involves physical exertion and carries a natural risk of accident, bodily injury (including death), as well as property damage and loss. Furthermore, participation in the race may involve other risk factors that are currently unpredictable. Signing the declaration of knowledge of the regulations signifies that the participant's parent/legal guardian has considered and assessed the scope and nature of the risks involved in participating in the race. The participant is participating voluntarily and solely at the parent/legal guardian's risk. Doctors' decisions regarding continued running during the event are final and irrevocable.
- 6. By registering a participant for the race, the parent/legal guardian accepts these regulations and consents to the free use of the participant's image, whether photographic or video, and grants the Organizer a free license to use it in all fields of exploitation, including: recording and

distributing it in any form and storing it in computer memory; using it to promote and organize events of the "Warsaw Marathon" Foundation; making it available to sponsors and partners of the Mini Marathon for the purpose of promoting their participation in the event; and posting and publishing it in the "Warsaw Marathon" Foundation's publications, on the Organizer's printed promotional materials, in the press, on websites, and in television and radio broadcasts.

- 7. The Organizer reserves the right to cancel or interrupt the race without providing a reason.
- 8. Placing advertising materials on elements of the race infrastructure (e.g., fences, gates, etc.) is the exclusive right of the Organizer and is specifically reserved for official sponsors/partners of the race. It is prohibited to place any advertising media along the race route or in the area used for organizing the race (e.g., the finish area, race town) without the Organizer's consent.
- 9. The binding and final interpretation of these regulations rests solely with the Nice To Fit You Mini Marathon organizer. In matters not covered by these regulations, the Organizer will decide. If any provision of these regulations is deemed invalid or unenforceable in whole or in part, all other provisions (in whole or in part) will remain in effect.

Who is the administrator of your personal data?

The administrator of your personal data is the "Warsaw Marathon" Foundation with its registered office in Warsaw at 15 Brylantowa str., 05-077 Warsaw (registered under Taxpayer Identification Number (NIP) 9521913280, Business Identification Number (REGON) 015438288, National Court Register (KRS): 0000152754). For what purpose and on what basis are your personal data processed?

- 1. provision of electronic services:
 - performance of the agreement that is, your participation in the race
- 2. performance of the agreement that is, your participation in the race:
 - participation in the races you apply for via the registration website rejestracja.maratonwarszawski.com (preparation of the race kit, insurance, results summarizing, awarding, etc.)
 - publishing publicly available starting lists and results
 - providing payment services
 - sending organizational information (e-mail / SMS) about the races you register for via the registration page rejestracja.maratonwarszawski.com
 - handling requests and correspondence that you direct to us
 - making contact with you
 - allowing a charity organization supported by you (in the case of charity registration path #IRunWell) to contact you
- 3. fulfillment of legal obligations of the "Warsaw Marathon" Foundation:
 - for tax and accounting purposes
- 4. for purposes resulting from the legitimate interests of the "Warsaw Marathon" Foundation:
 - conducting direct marketing of products and services
 - handling requests and correspondence that you direct to us
 - making contact with you
 - counteracting fraud and abuse
- 5. based on your consent:
 - sending marketing information (email / SMS)

Do you have to provide your personal data?

Providing personal data is necessary for both your participation in a race and keeping your account on the registration website rejestracja.maratonwarszawski.com.

Failure to provide your personal data makes it impossible to conclude the agreement and participate in the race.

How long will your personal data be processed?

Your data will be processed during the period of using the rejestracja.martonwarszawski.com website and participation in races for which you register via the Website.

At the end of this period, your data will continue to be stored for purposes arising from law (especially tax and accounting), as well as counteracting fraud and abuse and seeking possible claims under the agreement. Part of your data (especially those that are included in the results of the race) can also be processed after this term for statistical and archival purposes.

Who will be the recipient of your personal data?

Your personal data will be disclosed to employees, associates and subcontractors of the Administrator to the extent necessary for the implementation of the aforementioned purposes of processing personal data. Starting lists and results containing basic personal data will be publicly available, including the publication on the website of the race.

What rights do you have for the processing of your personal data?

You have the right to request: access to your personal data, correction, removal and restriction of their processing. In addition, you have the right to object to the processing and transfer of them. In addition, with respect to processing that takes place on the basis of your consent – you have the right to revoke it at any time.

Who can you complain to about how your personal data is processed?
